PUBLIC COMMENT:

James Fournier, 7219 Harvard – Mr. Fournier spoke about the upcoming proposed zoning ordinances, the creation of a public service district, and the public hearing with the planning commission on October 20th. He criticized the lack of community notification along with the potential environmental impact on protected wetlands, and discussed the Master Plan adopted in 2021. Mr. Fournier spoke upon the D.P.W. dumping dirt back in the area, and that he had contacted EGLE regarding the dumping.

David Gawne, 11015 Harvard – Mr. Gawne stated that he backed everything that Mr. Fournier said. He spoke upon there not being enough information out there for the public, and touched on the noise that this is going to cause in that area, and that it will upset a lot of people.

COUNCIL MEMBER AND STAFF COMMENTS:

Councilmember Walter, Smith, and Vance thanked everyone for coming in tonight.

Fire Chief Taylor stated that we have two firefighters who started the fire academy this past Saturday, and they are both doing well so far. He invited council members out to join them on Tuesday evenings for training, to get a glimpse of the training that goes on within the fire department.

Police Chief Mihailoff spoke upon Officer Butcher hopefully returning to full-duty soon. He spoke upon the City Manager being in contact with the EGLE office regarding the potential public service district, and if they say we cannot do it, then so be it. He spoke upon training and how the police department would like to train in the future.

Mayor Sara Dubey thanked everyone for coming out and expressing their opinions. She invited them to come on October 20th to the planning commission meeting as well to gather more information.

ORDINANCE 2025-06**

**An ordinance to amend the Zoning Ordinance, Appendix D, and
Zoning Map, of the Code of Ordinances, City of Mt. Morris, Michigan,
by the rezoning of certain property as hereinafter set forth:**

THE CITY OF MT. MORRIS ORDAINS:

SECTION I

The Mt. Morris Code of Ordinances, Appendix D, the Zoning Ordinance and the Zoning Map is hereby amended pursuant to Art.11, Zoning Ordinance Amendments, as follows:

Parcel no. 57-06-553-041, legally described as S 106.50 FT OF LOT 135 WALTER WISNER ADDITION, currently zoned R-2 “Residential – Medium Density” is hereby rezoned to RB “Residential – Multiple Family.”

Parcel no. 57-06-553-042, legally described as N 42 FT OF LOT 135 WALTER WISNER ADDITION & A PARCEL OF LAND BEG AT NE COR OF LOT 135 WALTER WISNER ADD TH N 33 FT TH W 99 FT TH S 33 FT TH E 99 FT TO PLACE OF BEG SEC 6 T8N R7E OWNED & OCCUPIED AS ONE PARCEL, currently zoned R-2 “Residential – Medium Density” is hereby rezoned to RB “Residential – Multiple Family.”

SECTION II

All other provisions of this Chapter shall be and are hereby ratified.

SECTION III - SEVERABILITY

If any part of this ordinance shall be determined to be unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, that part shall be deemed to be severed and removed from the body of this ordinance, and the rest shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION IV – PRIOR ORDINANCES

All City ordinances and resolutions or a part thereof, insofar as the same may be in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION V

This Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Mt. Morris, Genesee County, Michigan, and shall become effective on the 7th day after publication.

SECTION VI

A copy of this Ordinance may be inspected at the City Hall, 11649 N. Saginaw St., Mt. Morris, Michigan, during regular business hours.

WHEREAS: The City of Mt. Morris DPW has located 119 service lines that contain lead thus far; and

WHEREAS: DPW Superintendent Paul Zumbach has obtained proposals from local contractors to replace 10 service lines; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant thereto, quotes were received as follows:

WHEREAS: The said quotes have been reviewed by the Superintendent of Public Works and the manager and all have been found to be from responsible contractors and that the proposed work is pursuant to specifications; and,

WHEREAS: The cost of the services to be performed from the low bidder is \$44,250.00. Total cost will be appropriated from the Water Fund.

WHEREAS: Based upon the above, staff recommends that the low quote, to wit: Steve's Plumbing, be awarded the job;

**CITY OF MT. MORRIS
RESOLUTION 25-30**

WHEREAS: Code Section 58-113 relative to removal of snow and ice on sidewalks provides that the City Council shall establish, by resolution, the streets and properties to be covered by the requirement set forth in subparagraph (1) of said Code section with respect to requirement of snow removal within 24 hours of the end of a snowfall,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That this Council does hereby declare that the following streets shall be covered by the requirement that the owner of property situated thereon shall be required to remove accumulations of snow and ice upon the sidewalks adjacent to their property if the accumulation exceeds 3 inches or if icing conditions exist:

1. Saginaw Street from city limit to city limit.
2. Mt. Morris Street from city limit to city limit.
3. Walter Street from Mt. Morris Street to city limit.
4. Roosevelt Street from Saginaw Street to city limit.

And;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That a notice setting forth the requirement above stated shall be published by the City Clerk during the month of November in a paper of general circulation within the City and the City Clerk shall, also, employ other means of dissemination of the list of affected streets, but the effectiveness of the requirement shall not depend upon dissemination of the information other than the publication above specified.

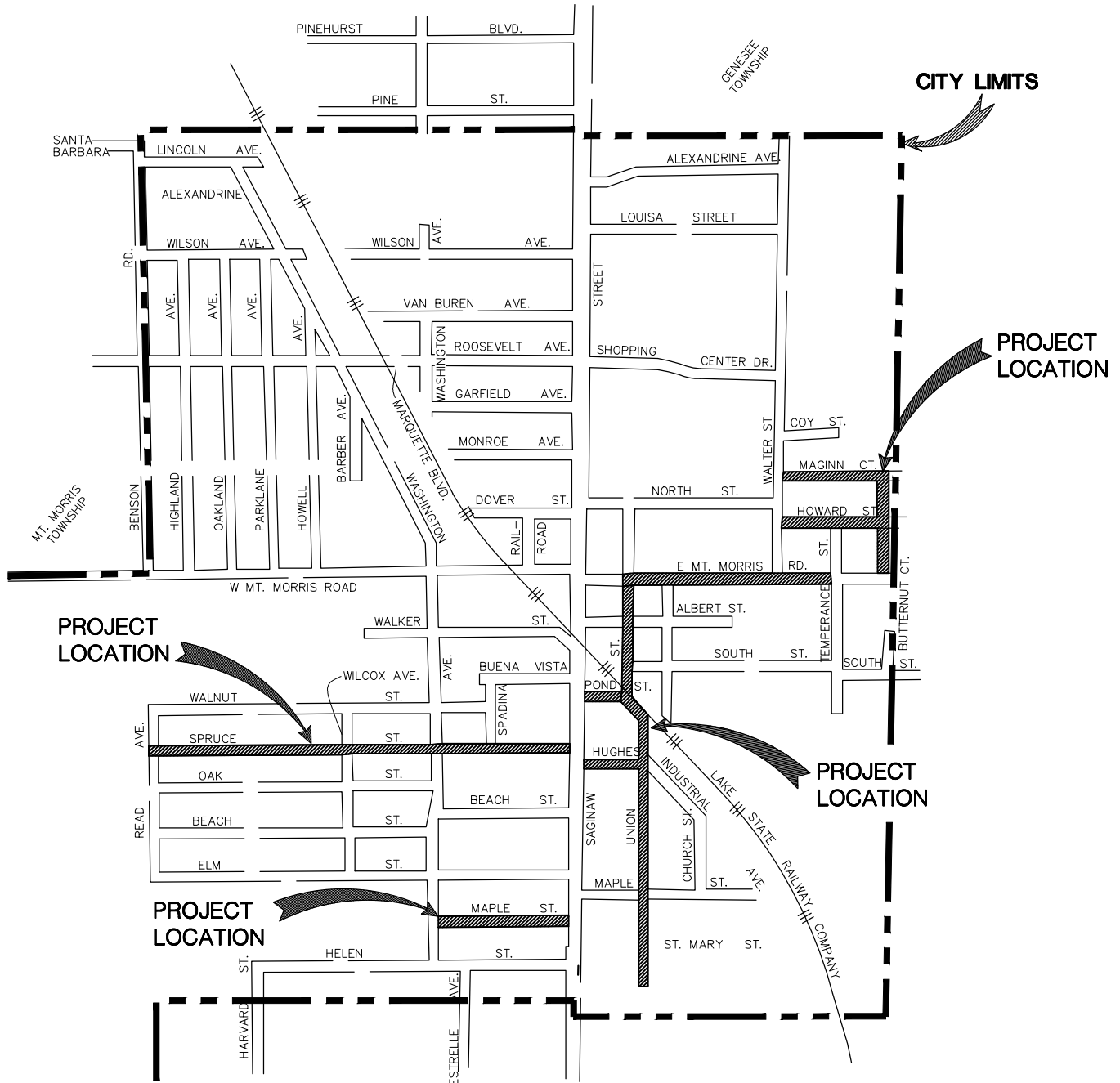

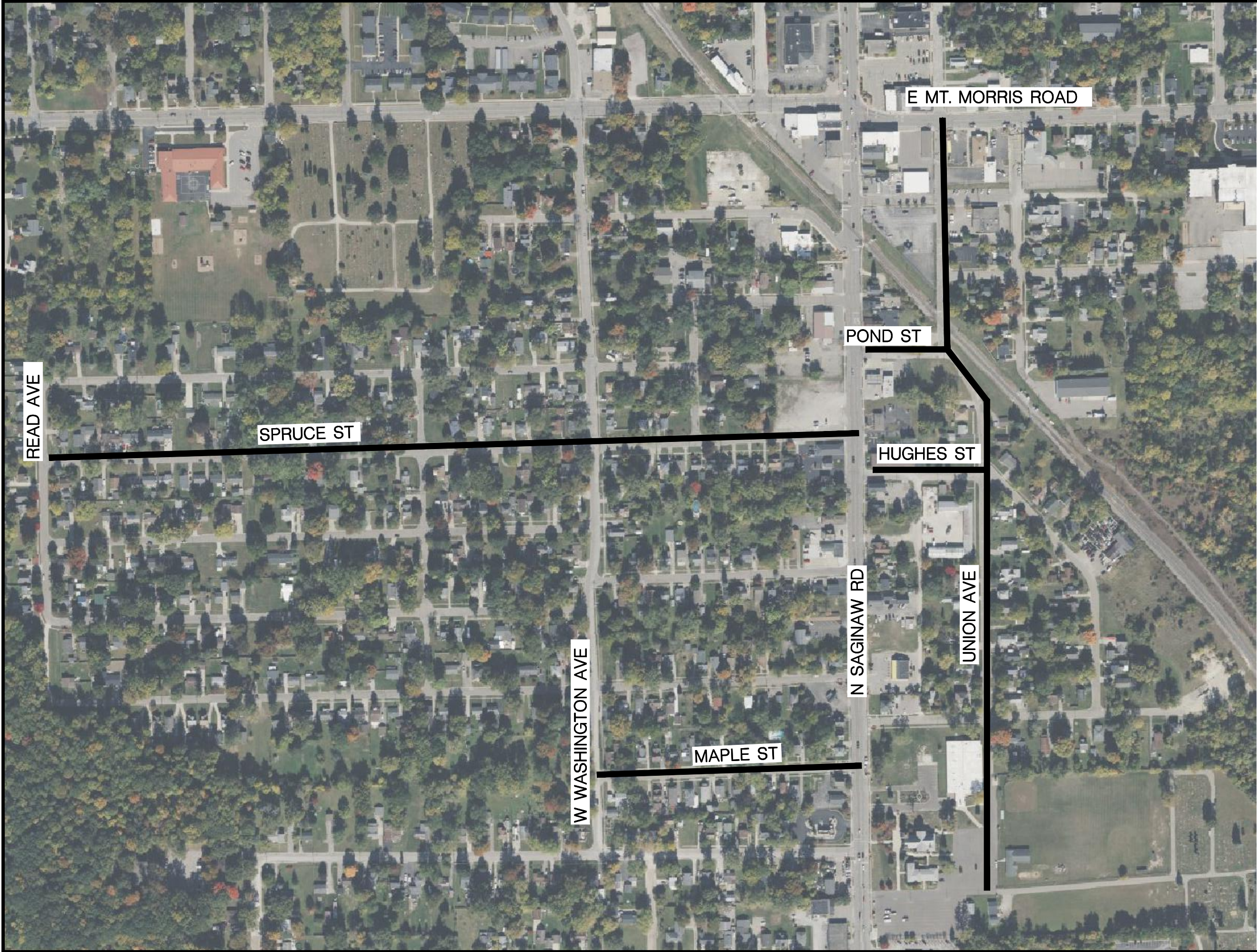
