ORDINANCE 2021 – 02**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MT. MORRIS CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, §§ 66-41 AND 66-42, REGULATIONS FOR CONNECTIONS, TO UPDATE PERMISSIBLE WATER SERVICE LINE TYPES.

THE CITY OF MT. MORRIS HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I

Chapter 66, Utilities, Article II, Water Supply, Division 2, Construction, Section 66-41(b) is hereby amended as follows:

(b) All materials and construction practices shall conform to the standards of the American Water Works Association (AWWA). An approved water meter shall be provided for each privately owned water main at the point where such main leaves public property or easement unless otherwise approved by council.

Chapter 66, Utilities, Article II, Water Supply, Division 2, Construction, Section 66-42(e) is hereby amended as follows:

(e) All materials used for construction of service lines, up to and including the water meter fittings, shall be approved by the city. As a condition of receiving water service, the city may require repair or replacement of service lines as necessary to prevent loss of unmetered water. A water service line standard shall be any AWWA approved material for potable water.

SECTION II

All other provisions of this Chapter shall be and are hereby ratified.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Mt. Morris, Genesee County, Michigan, and shall become effective upon publication.


SECTION IV
